Basil	Downy mildew (Peronospora belbahrii)	5.5 - 8.0 (0.09 - 0.13)	Apply no more than two applications containing Micora per crop. One application may be made during the plug growing stage and one application may be made during the crop finishing stage. Begin applications prior to disease development and continue on a 7-10 day interval. Make no more than 2 consecutive applications before switching to another effective non-Group 40 fungicide. Use the shorter interval and/or higher rates under high pressure or when conditions are conducive to disease. Micora may be tank mixed with another fungicide labeled for downy mildew that has a different mode of action. The addition of a spreading/penetrating type adjuvant such as a non-ionic based surfactant or crop oil concentrate or blend is recommended.

Application: For best results, use sufficient water volume to provide thorough coverage. Micora may be applied by ground application or chemigation.

Specific Use Restrictions:

- Do not apply more than 16 fl oz of product/A/crop (0.26 lb a.i./A/crop).
- Do not apply within 1 day of harvest (1-day PHI).
